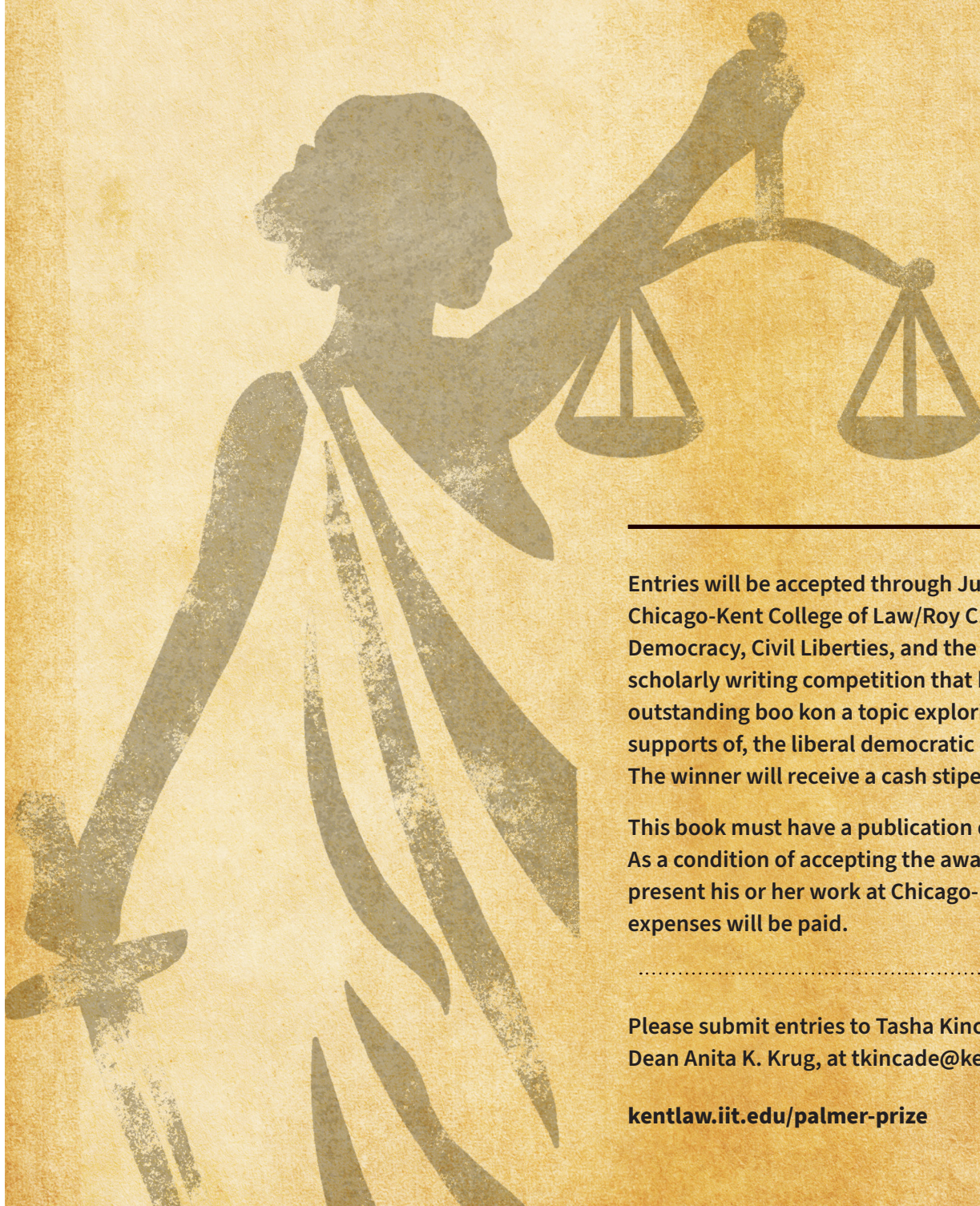


2024 Chicago-Kent College of Law

Roy C. Palmer Prize on Democracy, Civil Liberties, and the Rule of Law



Entries will be accepted through July 1, 2024 for the Chicago-Kent College of Law/Roy C. Palmer Prize on Democracy, Civil Liberties, and the Rule of Law, a scholarly writing competition that honors an outstanding book on a topic exploring threats to, or supports of, the liberal democratic constitutional order. The winner will receive a cash stipend of \$10,000.

This book must have a publication date of 2023 or 2024. As a condition of accepting the award, the winner will present his or her work at Chicago-Kent. All reasonable expenses will be paid.
