<b>Language Requirements</b>	TOEFL score of at least 100, IELTS score of at least 6.5, or a letter from nominating institution's language instructor confirming student's English language proficiency. In addition, we now accept Duolingo English Test scores of at least 110 for proof of English proficiency.

<b>Nominations</b>	<p>Nominations should be sent directly to Sara Rusnak via <a href="mailto:srusnak@kentlaw.iit.edu">srusnak@kentlaw.iit.edu</a> and should include the following information:  <b>Legal Name, Date of Birth, Year in current program, email address, confirmation of English Language proficiency.</b></p> <p>Nominated students will be provided the full application procedures (including the online application form link) once their nomination is received by Wirdani Peters.</p> <p><b>Deadline for nominations: March 1<sup>st</sup> for following fall term start (August); September 1<sup>st</sup> for following spring term start (January).</b></p>

<b>Program Length</b>	The typical exchange program is one academic semester, however, some students opt to study for two semesters (one year) permitted Chicago-Kent and by the student's home school. Nominated students should indicate on their application form their desired program length.
<b>Visa Requirements</b>	Students who plan to complete the one semester exchange option will be provided an application form for the U.S. J-1 Student Exchange Visa, should they be admitted to the program. Those who plan to complete the full year will be issued an application form for the U.S. F-1 Student Visa.
<b>Health Insurance</b>	All international exchange students are required to purchase the IIT Student Health Insurance plan unless they can provide proof of health coverage from a U.S. health provider subject to the approval of the IIT Student Health Center.
