

Language Requirements	TOEFL score of at least 100, IELTS score of at least 6.5, or a letter from nominating institution's language instructor confirming student's English language proficiency. In addition, we now accept Duolingo English Test scores of at least 110 for proof of English proficiency.

Nominations	Nominations should be sent directly to Sara Rusnak via srusnak@kentlaw.iit.edu and should include the following information: Legal Name, Date of Birth, Year in current program, email address, confirmation of English Language proficiency. Nominated students will be provided the full application procedures (including the online application form link) once their nomination is received by Wirdani Peters. Deadline for nominations: March 1 st for following fall term start (August); September 1 st for following spring term start (January).	

Program Length	The typical exchange program is one academic semester, however, some students opt to study for two semesters (one year) permitted Chicago-Kent and by the student's home school. Nominated students should indicate on their application form their desired program length.
Visa Requirements	Students who plan to complete the one semester exchange option will be provided an application form for the U.S. J-1Student Exchange Visa, should they be admitted to the program. Those who plan to complete the full year will be issued an application form for the U.S. F-1 Student Visa.
Health Insurance	All international exchange students are required to purchase the IIT Student Health Insurance plan unless they can provide proof of health coverage from a U.S. health provider subject to the approval of the IIT Student Health Center.
