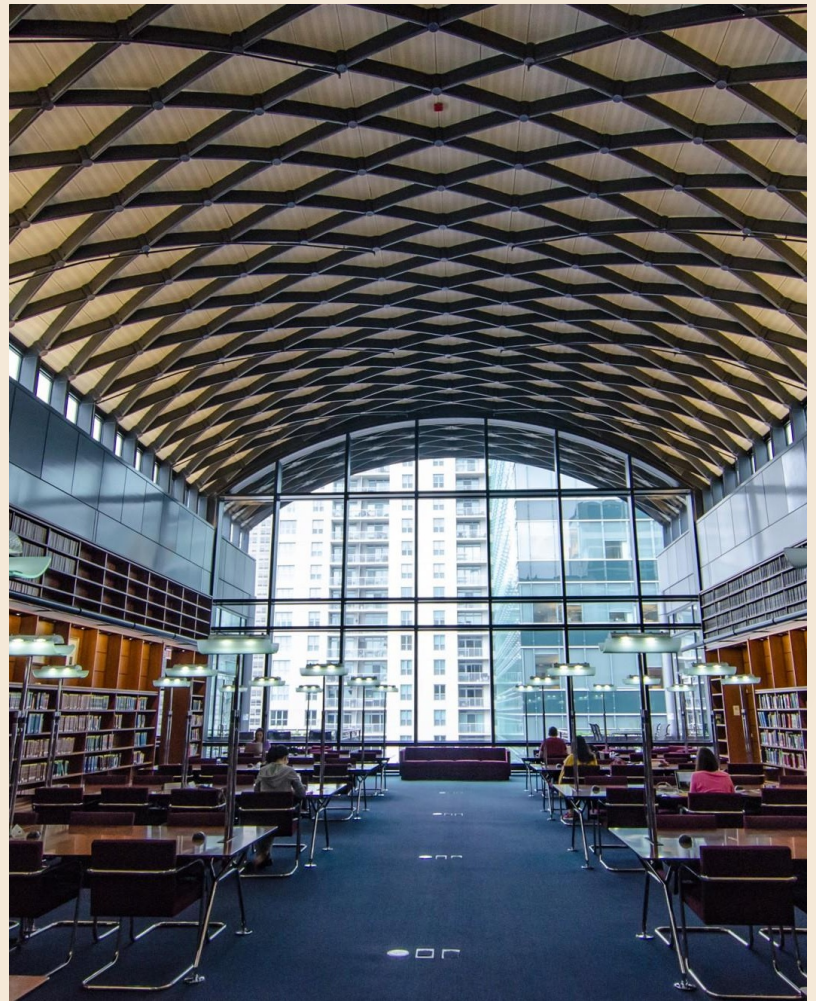

Language Requirements	TOEFL score of at least 100, IELTS score of at least 6.5, or a letter from the nominating institution's language instructor confirming the student's English language proficiency. Duolingo English Test scores of at least 110 are also accepted as proof of English proficiency.

Nominations	<p>Nominations should be sent directly to Wirdani Peters via wmohdyusoff@illinoistech.edu and should include the following information: Legal Name, Date of Birth, Year in current program, email address, confirmation of English language proficiency.</p> <p>Nominated students will be provided the full application procedures (including the online application form link) once their nomination is received.</p> <p>Deadline for nominations: March 1st for following fall term start (August); September 1st for following spring term start (January).</p>

Program Length	The typical exchange program is one academic semester; however, some students opt to study for two semesters (one year) when permitted by Chicago-Kent and by the student's home school. Nominated students should indicate their desired program length on their application form.
Visa Requirements	Students who plan to complete the one-semester exchange option will be provided an application form for the U.S. J-1 Student Exchange Visa upon admission to the program. Those who plan to complete the full year will be issued an application form for the U.S. F-1 Student Visa. Daniele Acciari, our Designated School Official (DSO), oversees visa documentation and can assist with related questions.
Health Insurance	All international exchange students are required to purchase the IIT Student Health Insurance plan unless they can provide proof of health coverage from a U.S. health provider, subject to the approval of the IIT Student Health Center.
